



Personal & Professional Code of Treatment Ethics

Code of Professional Ethics to guide all practitioners and treatment providers.

1. Inform appropriate parties of the results of work performed including the disclosure of all significant facts known to them.
2. Respect and protect the rights of a patient. Staff will respect the right of a patient to make her/his own choices about health.
3. Staff will not misrepresent herself or himself through any form of communication in an untruthful manner.

Personal & Professional Code of Business Ethics

Code of Business Ethics to guide the conduct of all members.

Members Shall:

1. Support the implementation of, and encourage compliance with, appropriate standards and procedures.
2. Perform their duties with objectivity, due diligence and professional care, in accordance with professional standards.
3. Serve in the interest of patients, while maintaining high standards of conduct.
4. Maintain the privacy and confidentiality of information obtained in the course of their activities unless disclosure is required by legal authority. Such information shall not be used for personal benefit or released to inappropriate parties.
5. Maintain competency in their respective fields and agree to undertake only those activities they can reasonably expect to complete with the necessary skills, knowledge and competence.
6. Support the professional education of members in enhancing their understanding of the Oriental Medicine field.
7. Maintain strict avoidance of discrimination on the basis of race, religion, national origin, sexual orientation or any other basis that would constitute illegal discrimination.
